The primary responsibility of a Ronald McDonald Family Room or Ronald McDonald House volunteer is to assist in providing a "home-away-from-home" for families of children. Our volunteers do a little bit of everything, including checking in families, baking desserts, restocking rooms, light housekeeping, answering phones, assisting with mailings, data entry, and more.

Generally our volunteers commit to a three-hour shift each week. The Family Rooms operate with volunteers and staff 7 a.m.-9 p.m. daily. The House operates with volunteers and staff 24/365.
